

## SUCCESSFUL BIRD CONTROL IN OPEN SPACES LIKE THIS LUMBER YARD



A lumber yard had a bird control issue that just wouldn't go away. They inquired about the Bird Buffer™ for bird control.

Netting and spikes just weren't an option in such an open, busy area. The birds were flying in and out of the open warehouse doors freely, day and night.

At one point there was such an accumulation

of droppings that you couldn't see the floor or the eye-wash station.
